# Incyte Biosciences UK Limited: Methodological note for Patient Organisations and members of the public

*(Including Patients and Journalists)*

Incyte Biosciences UK Ltd (hereinafter referred to as “Incyte”) fully supports the transparency requirements set out in the Association of the British Pharmaceutical Industry (ABPI) Code of Practice and is committed to making public the details of all Transfers of Value (ToV) made to patient organisations, and where applicable, to members of the public, including patients and journalists.

This methodological note sets out the approach used by Incyte to prepare and present its disclosure information.

## **Definitions**

For the purposes of this disclosure, the following definitions apply:

### **Transfer of Value (ToV)**

A Transfer of Value means a direct transfer of value, whether in cash or otherwise, made by Incyte for the benefit of a recipient in connection with activities covered by the ABPI Code of Practice.

For the 2025 reporting period, Incyte made direct Transfers of Value only. No indirect Transfers of Value or benefits in kind were provided.

### **Patient Organisation (PO)**

A Patient Organisation is a not-for-profit organisation that represents and/or supports the needs of patients and/or caregivers and whose registered address, place of incorporation or primary place of operation is in the United Kingdom.

### **Patient Organisation Representative**

An individual who is authorised to represent and express the views of a Patient Organisation on a specific issue or disease area.

### **Members of the Public**

For the purposes of this disclosure, members of the public may include patients,

patient advocates, caregivers and journalists, where they are engaged by Incyte to provide contracted services in accordance with the ABPI Code of Practice.

- **Patient / Patient Expert**

An individual acting in a personal capacity as a patient, patient advocate or caregiver, who provides insights based on lived experience of a health condition or its impact on patients and caregivers.

- **Journalist**

An individual who is not a healthcare professional and whose role involves writing, presenting or communicating information through print, digital or broadcast media, including newspapers, magazines, websites, television or radio, whether on an employed, self-employed or voluntary basis.

## **Scope**

Under the ABPI Code of Practice, pharmaceutical companies are required to publish, on an annual basis, details of Transfers of Value made to UK patient organisations. This includes:

- Donations, grants and sponsorships, and
- Fees paid for certain contracted services.

Where required under the Code, this disclosure may also include details of fees paid to members of the UK public, including patients and journalists, for contracted services.

Transfers of Value to members of the public, including patients and journalists, are disclosed in aggregate and not at an individual level.

Transfers of Value are disclosed in the year in which the payment is made or the benefit in kind is provided, regardless of when the related agreement was signed.

The reporting period covers all payments or benefits in kind made to recipients between 1 January and 31 December 2025.

## **Benefits in Kind**

Incyte did not provide any Transfers of Value in the form of benefits in kind to patient organisations, patients or journalists during the 2025 reporting period.

## **Third-Party or Intermediary Payments**

Incyte did not make any Transfers of Value via third-party vendors or intermediaries on behalf of patient organisations, patients or journalists during the 2025 reporting period.

## **Currency**

All Transfers of Value are disclosed in British Pound Sterling (GBP).

Where a Transfer of Value was made in another currency, the exchange rate applicable at the time of payment was used to convert the value into GBP for disclosure purposes.

### **Value Added Tax (VAT)**

ToV are disclosed inclusive of VAT where applicable, in line with Incyte's internal reporting methodology and UK tax treatment.

### **Multi-year Contracts**

Incyte did not have any multi-year contracts with patient organisations, patients or journalists during the 2025 reporting period.

### **Data Accuracy and Review**

The disclosure data has been reviewed internally to ensure accuracy and completeness and has been prepared in accordance with the ABPI Code of Practice and Incyte's internal controls.
